

Utah Fox Trotting Horse Association 2011 STALLION SHOWCASE RULES

Stallion owners must be current (2011) members of the Utah Fox Trotting Horse Association. (UFTHA)
Any registered MFTHBA, DNA tested stallion is eligible.

All horses must be stalled.

Stallion owner pays \$75 fee to participate in auction and will be listed with full-page ad in Member Handbook, Stallion Directory and on the UFTHA website (www.uftha.com).

Layout of Stallion Directory to be determined by Board for consistency.

Deadline for entry: Stallion entry form, picture, \$75 entry fee, (stall fee included) and current year membership dues (\$30) must be received by February 19, 2011 (contact information below).

One breed per stallion will be made available for service auction.

All costs (travel, board, veterinary care, A.I., shipping etc.) are borne by bidder unless otherwise noted.

Bidding for stallion service will start at \$200.

Successful bidders must pay in full the day of the auction.

Stallion owners must provide a live foal guarantee.

Stallion owners must provide all reasonable accommodations to holder of winning bid to breed designated mare from March 19th to the end of current breeding season. All obligations now lie between stallion owner and mare owner.

Stallion owner may provide a copy of their service contract if so desired.

Failure to comply with any of the showcase rules could disqualify the stallion and its offspring from participation in future stallion showcases. In addition, the stallion owner may be required to reimburse the winning bid amount to the winning bidder.

FUTURITY: Futurity classes will be held at the 2011 Great Western Show and are open to any MFTHBA registered Fox Trotter. Nomination fee will be \$100 (\$75 to be paid out in the class entered, with \$25 retained by UFTHA), WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTION: MFTHBA registered offspring from winning bids at 2005 – 2008 stallion showcase are eligible for futurity through 3-year old year for a \$50 nomination fee. Class fee of \$10 and office fee of \$5 to be paid in addition to nomination fee.

Futurity classes will be as follows:

Model Yearling Filly

Model Yearling Colt/Gelding

Model 2 year old Filly

Model 2 year old Colt/Gelding

3 year old Performance Two-Gait

Senior Performance Two-Gait (4 years and older)

Payout: Payout will include \$75 of \$100 nomination fee, or \$50 of \$50 nomination fee, paid out in class entered; plus any added sponsorship money designated for the Futurity and 50% of net proceeds from stallion service auction, to be apportioned equally between the six futurity classes.

1 entry: 1st Place- 100% of Purse

2 entries: 1st place – 60% of Purse; 2nd Place- 40% of Purse

3 entries: 1st place – 40% of Purse; 2nd Place – 33% of Purse; 3rd Place- 27% of Purse

4 or more entries: 1st place – 33% of Purse; 2nd Place – 27% of Purse; 3rd Place – 22% of Purse; 4th Place- 18% of Purse

c. The winning horse of the 2011 Senior Performance Two-Gait Futurity class will be ineligible to enter the Senior Performance Two-Gait Futurity class in 2012 with the same registered owner.

All horses must be registered for Futurity and paid in full by June 23, 2011 (3 weeks prior to the first day of the 2011 Great Western). No refunds are allowed after this time.

Any nomination fee received after June 23, 2011 will incur an additional \$50 late fee.

All entrants for Futurity must have original MFTHBA papers available for inspection.

All Judges' decisions are final.
